- 🌊 Elm Class will be enjoying swimming lessons in the new year, a fantastic opportunity to build confidence and develop important life skills.


As we look forward to the new year, we are excited for the opportunities and adventures that await. Thank you for your continued support in making our school such a vibrant and caring community.
